A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON

Resolution No. 3

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be eliminated on a portion of Oak Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Parking is hereby prohibited:

- 1) along 70 feet of the North side of Oak Street, East of 5th Street; and
- 2) along 80 feet of the South side of Oak Street, West of 5th Street.

Suitable signs shall be erected and markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
