

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

RESOLUTION NO. 21
for 1981

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that Temporary "No Parking" be permitted on West Rose Street, between 5th and 3rd Streets; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is hereby restricted for a period of one week beginning June 1 through June 7, 1981, on West Rose Street, between 5th & 3rd Streets.

Section 2. Suitable signs shall be erected designating the Temporary "No Parking" areas and such designations shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 27th day of May, 1981.
