PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON. )

RESOLUTION NO. 24  
for 1981

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be regulated on a portion of Morton Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is hereby limited Monday through Saturday for a period of time not to exceed ten (10) minutes for each instance of use for the following described portion of Morton Street:

A parking area on the north side of Morton Street beginning thirty (30) feet west of the curb on the west side of Santiam Highway and extending westward ninety-five (95) feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected in appropriate places designating a ten (10) minute limit for parking and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 10<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1981.
