

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

RESOLUTION NO. 25
for 1981

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be regulated on a portion of Morton Street.


WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is hereby prohibited along the north side of Morton Street from Santiam Highway to a point thirty (30) feet west of the west curb on Santiam Highway.


Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted in appropriate places prohibiting parking; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
