

A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING VEHICLE TRAFFIC)
IN THE CITY OF LEBANON.)

RESOLUTION NO. 34
for 1981

WHEREAS, Oak Street Bridge has been experiencing problems with its approach fills; and

WHEREAS, heavy vehicles have a tendency to aggravate the situation; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon has given Cities the authority to restrict the gross weight of vehicles operating upon certain roads within their jurisdiction (ORS 487.905); and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that a fifteen (15) ton load limit be established for the Oak Street Bridge; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic and is reasonable and necessary for the protection of the Oak Street Bridge.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Vehicle traffic with a total gross weight exceeding fifteen (15) tons is hereby prohibited from crossing, standing upon, or otherwise encroaching within twenty (20) feet of the Oak Street Bridge which is located on East Oak Street approximately one hundred (100) feet east of Park Street and which spans the Santiam Canal.

Section 2. Emergency vehicles responding on an emergency call shall be exempt from this restriction.


Section 3. Suitable signs shall be erected in appropriate places indicating such a restriction, and such designation shall be a part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
