RESOLUTION NO. 47
for 1981

WHEREAS, a section of "A" Street has been approved by City Council to function as a one-way street; and

WHEREAS, that section of "A" Street has been designed and constructed to function as a one-way street.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All vehicle traffic is hereby restricted to one-way travel from West to East for the following described portion of "A" Street:

That portion of "A" Street Right-of-way beginning at the West Right-of-way line of Main Street and extending Westward one hundred sixty (160) feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected in appropriate places designating the one-way direction and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 9th day of December, 1981.
