

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

RESOLUTION NO. 48
for 1981

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be regulated on a portion of "A" Street.

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is hereby prohibited along both sides of that portion of "A" Street beginning on the West Right-of-way lane of Main Street and extending Westward one hundred sixty (160) feet.


Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted in appropriate places prohibiting parking; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
