A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PREPARE A PRELIMINARY ENGINEER'S REPORT FOR SANITARY SEWER, STREET, SIDEWALK, AND STORM DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE PROPOSED LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AS "SOUTH MAIN ROAD PROJECT". RESOLUTION NO. 4

WHEREAS, the City Council has discussed the need for certain improvements on portions of South Main Road, Walker Road, Second Street, Market Street, and Airport Road; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined by Motion that a Local Improvement District would be the most reasonable method of providing said improvements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the City Council intends to initiate a Local Improvement District for improvements to the before mentioned streets; and,

<u>Section 2</u>. That the Local Improvement District shall be known as "South Main Road Project"; and

<u>Section 3</u>. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to prepare a map and preliminary engineering report as defined in Ordinance No. 1681; and

<u>Section 4</u>. That the costs of said report shall be charged to said proposed L.I.D. upon its creation.
