RESOLUTION NO. 20
For 1982

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that temporary "No Parking" be permitted on West Rose Street, between 5th and 3rd Streets; and


WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is hereby restricted for a period of one week beginning June 1, 1982 through June 7, 1982 on West Rose Street, between 5th and 3rd Streets.


Section 2. Suitable signs shall be erected designating the temporary "No Parking" areas and such designations shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
