AMENDMENT NO. 3

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into this 14th day of September 1983, by and between the City of Lebanon and OMI. This is Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement dated the 18th day of June, 1982, between the above named parties for the provision by OMI of Operation and Management Services to the Owner for its Treatment Plant. This Amendment is for the sole purpose of sharing cost savings realized by OMI from the efficient utilization of manpower and other resources at the Treatment Plant and to set forth compensation owing to Owner for the limited use of Owner's equipment at other treatment facilities as described in Appendix A attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree to replace Section 6.1 of Amendment No. 2, dated May 4, 1983, with the negotiated terms as follows:

6.1 Owner shall pay to OMI as compensation for services performed in accordance with the provisions of Article 5 herein, except for those additional amounts provided for in Article 5, the Base Fee of Three Hundred Forty Eight Thousand Dollars (\$348,000) annually for each year during the term of this Agreement, with adjustments as hereinafter specified. The adjusted Annual Base Fee shall be paid according to the schedule attached. Owner will pay in accordance with Section 7.1.

All other terms and conditions remain in effect in accordance with the Agreement and Amendments.

APPENDIX A

The City of Lebanon owns the following equipment to dispose of digested sludge from the wastewater treatment facility.

- o 4000 gallon trailer mounted sludge tank with GMC trailer
- o Tractor with a front end loader accessory
- o Aluminum pipe, spray nozzle and pipe trailer
- o Portable sludge pump

OMI wishes to utilize all or part of the above equipment for the spray application of sludge from the City of Philomath, Oregon wastewater treatment plant for a period of approximately two weeks total each year. As compensation to Owner for the use of said equipment OMI is reducing the Annual Base Fee by One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000). Such reduction is reflected in the Annual Base Fee contained in Amendment 3.
