

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET )  
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON. )

RESOLUTION NO. 16  
for 1984.

WHEREAS, a loading zone has existed in the past on the North side of Sherman Street as described below; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that the loading zone be reestablished for the use of nearby businesses; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking is hereby restricted except momentarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading property or passengers in the following described area;

1) In the parallel parking stall located on the North side of Sherman Street between Main Street and Park Street, more specifically described as the curbside parking area beginning 85.0 feet from the East side curb line of Main Street and extending eastward 25.0 feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or marking may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, and approved by the Mayor this 27<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1984.
