A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET) RESOLUTION NO. 27
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON) for 1985

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be restricted to DMV Disabled Permit holders only on portions of Park Street;

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking is hereby restricted to DMV Disabled Permit holders only:

1) In the parallel parking stall located on the East side of Park Street, between Ash Street and Vine Street, more specifically described as that curbside parking area on the east side of Park Street beginning 35.0 feet from the north side curb line of Ash Street and extending eastward 23.0 feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of $\frac{4}{9}$ for and $\frac{6}{9}$ against, and approved by the Mayor this $\frac{28}{9}$ day of August, 1985.
