PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON.)

RESOLUTION NO. 27
for 1986

WHEREAS, the Oregon State Highway Division is widening Main Street; and
WHEREAS, this may cause tall vehicles to come into contact with the
existing Theater Marquee; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon Fire Marshal has requested that no parked
vehicles be allowed in front of the building during theater hours; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be regulated
on a portion of Main Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for
the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON,
AS FOLLOWS:

Parking is hereby limited to compact car parking during non-
theater hours and no parking during theater hours.

1) The two parallel parking stalls located on the West side
of Main Street, between Ash Street and Sherman Street, more
specifically described as that curbside parking area adjacent
to the movie theater, located on Tax Lot 3101 of Map 12-2W-10DA.


Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings may be painted in the
appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic
regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

and approved by the Mayor this 23rd day of July, 1986.
