A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON.

RESOLUTION NO. 28

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be eliminated on portions of City streets; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Parking is hereby prohibited on Eddie Street, Williams Street and Wheeler Street, as follows:

- A. Along the East side of Eddie Street from the South side curb line of Elmore Street and extending southward 34.0 feet.
- B. Along the West side of Eddie Street from the South side curb line of Elmore Street and extending southward 32.0 feet.
- C. Along the East side of Williams Street from the South side curb line of Wheeler Street and extending southward 160.0 feet.
- D. Along the South side of Wheeler Street from the West side curb line of Williams Street and extending westward 53.0 feet.

Suitable markings shall be painted and/or signs erected in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 4 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 23rd day of 1986.
