A RESOLUTION REGULATING TRAFFIC IN THE CITY OF LEBANON RELATING TO REGULATORY SIGNS.

RESOLUTION NO. 35 for 1986

WHEREAS, the installation of a yield sign was authorized by Resolution #35 for 1985 at the location described below; and

WHEREAS, the installation has not proven to adequately control the flow of traffic at this location; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of this sign is deemed reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of vehicle traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The yield sign restriction to North bound traffic on Second Street at Kees Street is hereby removed.

<u>Section 2.</u> A stop sign will be installed at the location described above and shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution supercedes and replaces all other Resolutions or parts thereof governing yield signs at this location.
