

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

RESOLUTION No. 43
for 1986

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be restricted to School Bus Parking Only on portions of Harrison Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking is hereby restricted to School Bus Parking Only between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 2:00 P.M. Tuesday through Thursday:

1) In the parallel parking stalls located on the South side of Harrison Street, between Second Street and Third Street, more specifically described as that curbside parking area on the South side of Harrison Street beginning 79 feet West of the West side curb line of Second Street and extending Westward 52 feet.


Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
