

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

RESOLUTION No. 44
for 1986

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be restricted to compact cars on portions of Second Street;

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking is hereby restricted to compact cars only:

1) In the parallel parking stalls located on the East and West sides of Second Street, between Morton Street and Harrison Street.


Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
