WHEREAS, the installment, and removal, of certain signs are deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of vehicle and pedestrian traffic in the City of Lebanon at the locations described below:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Signs shall be erected as follows:


<u>Street</u>	<u>Travel Direction</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Type sign</u>
Harrison St.	EB	@ Second Street	STOP
Second St.	SB	@ Morton Street	STOP
Second St.	NB	@ Morton Street	STOP
"F" St.	WB	@ Tenth Street	STOP
Second St.	NB	@ Morton Street	Right Turn Permitted W\OUT Stopping

Section 2. Sign shall be Removed:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Travel Direction</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Type sign</u>
Morton St.	WB	@ Second Street	STOP


Section 3. This Resolution supercedes and replaces all other Resolutions or parts thereof governing signs at these locations.
