

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

RESOLUTION NO. 10
for 1987

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be regulated on a portion of Jennings Street;

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking is hereby prohibited along a portion of the south side of Jennings Street, more specifically described as that curbside parking area on the south side of Jennings Street beginning at the east curb line of Main Street and extending Eastward 46 feet.

The provisions of this Resolution supercede and take precedence over conflicting portions of previous Ordinances and Resolutions.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 8th day of April, 1987.
