RESOLUTION NO. 11
for 1987

WHEREAS: The Congress of the United States has proclaimed that May 3-9 shall be recognized as "Fire Service Appreciation Week."

WHEREAS: Governor Neil Goldschmidt has proclaimed that May 3-9 shall be recognized as Oregon "Fire Service Appreciation Week."

WHEREAS: Oregon Fire Service is composed of 2600 paid and 8800 volunteer personnel in over 400 departments, districts, and volunteer companies.

WHEREAS: The men and women of the Oregon Fire Service are dedicated to providing fire protection, fire prevention, public education, home safety inspections, pre-fire planning, Fire and Life Safety Code enforcement, and emergency medical services.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:
