RESOLUTION No. 29
for 1987

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be regulated on a portion of Seventh Street;


WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking is hereby prohibited along a portion of the east side of Seventh Street, more specifically described as that curbside parking area on the east side of Seventh Street beginning at the south curb line of Oak Street and extending Southward to the north curb line of D Street.


The provisions of this Resolution supercede and take precedence over conflicting portions of previous Ordinances and Resolutions.
