

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

RESOLUTION No. 3
for 1987

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be regulated on a portion of Morton Street.

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking is hereby prohibited along a portion of the North side of Morton Street, between North Main Street and Second Street, more specifically described as that curbside parking area on North side of Morton Street beginning at the East curb line of Second Street and extending Eastward 89 feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
