

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

RESOLUTION No. 4
for 1987

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be restricted to Police Vehicle Parking Only on portions of Maple Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:


Parking is hereby restricted to Police Vehicle Parking Only:

- 1) In the parallel parking stalls located on the South side of Maple Street, between Main Street and Park Street, more specifically described as that curbside parking area on the South side of Maple Street beginning 95 feet East of the East side curb line of Main Street and extending Eastward 46 feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

This Resolution supercedes and replaces all other Resolutions or parts thereof governing parking at this location.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 28th day of January, 1987.
