CROSSWALKS IN THE CITY OF LEBANON )

RESOLUTION No. 5  
for 1988

WHEREAS, the Oregon State Department of Transportation Highway Division has proposed that a certain crosswalk on Main Street be closed; and

WHEREAS, there is a concern for the safety of pedestrians using this crosswalk; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that the crossing be closed; and

WHEREAS, such closure is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

The crosswalk on Main Street located just south of the intersection of Main Street and West Grant Street is hereby closed to pedestrian traffic.
