PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

RESOLUTION NO. 11
for 1988

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be regulated on a portion of Park Street;

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:


Parking is hereby prohibited along a portion of the west side of Park Street, more specifically described as that curbside parking area on the west side of Park Street beginning at the south curb line of Maple Street and extending Southward a distance of 80 feet.

The provisions of this Resolution supercede and take precedence over conflicting portions of previous Ordinances and Resolutions.
