WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that the direction of traffic flow be restricted in the alley bordered by Maple, Grant, Second, and Third Streets; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Lebanon as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The direction of flow for traffic using the alley bordered by Maple, Grant, Second, and Third Streets shall be controlled and limited to northbound only.

Suitable signs shall be erected and markings painted and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
