A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET ) PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON ) RESOLUTION No. <u>30</u> for 1988

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking restrictions be removed from a portion of 2nd Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be restricted on a portion of 2nd Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking restrictions are hereby removed along the west side of 2nd Street from Mary Street to Twin Oaks Drive.

Parking is hereby prohibited along the east side of 2nd Street from Mary Street north to Twin Oaks Drive and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

The provisions of this Resolution supercede and take precedence over conflicting portions of previous Ordinances and Resolutions.
