

A RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET)
PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON)

RESOLUTION No. 34
for 1988

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be restricted on a portion of Walker Road; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking is hereby prohibited along the north side of Walker Road from the west curb line of South Main Road to a point 240 feet west, and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

The provisions of this Resolution supercede and take precedence over conflicting portions of previous Ordinances and Resolutions.

Passed by Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 14th day of December, 1988.
