Gentlemen & Ladies:

The Oregon State Highway Division (State) and the City of Lebanon (Agency) entered into a local agency agreement, dated July 16, 1987, concerning the reconstruction of a 0.23 mile segment of 5th Street, Airport Road-Kees Street, project.

State and Agency have now determined that the aforementioned agreement, although remaining in full force and effect, should be supplemented by this agreement in order to change the funding structure. Any further reference to the original agreement shall include the following provisions:

paragraph 1. which reads, in part;

"...Local matching shares of the project costs are based on the current working agreements with the Association of Oregon Counties and the League of Oregon Cities. Federal-Aid Urban funds will provide 88 percent, and Agency and State each providing 6 percent match."

shall be changed to read;

"...Local matching shares of the project costs are based on the current working agreements with the Association of Oregon Counties and the League of Oregon Cities. Federal-Aid Urban funds will provide 82 percent, and Agency and State each providing 9 percent match." IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have set their hands and affixed their seals as of the day and year hereinafter written.

This project was approved by the State Highway Engineer on April 8, 1987 under delegated authority from the Oregon Transportation Commission.

The Oregon Transportation Commission, by a duly adopted delegation order, authorized the State Highway Engineer to sign this agreement for and on behalf of the Commission. Said authority is set forth in the Minutes of the Oregon Transportation Commission.
