

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING STREET)
PARKING ON A PORTION OF MAPLE STREET)

RESOLUTION NO. 21
for 1989

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be prohibited on a portion of Maple Street between 2nd Street and 3rd Street; and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking shall be prohibited on a portion of Maple Street between 2nd Street and 3rd Street, more specifically described as that curb side parking area on the south side of Maple Street beginning 149 feet west of the 2nd Street right of way centerline and extending westward 20 feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.


This Resolution supercedes and replaces all other Resolutions or parts thereof governing parking at this location.
