

A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING STREET )  
PARKING ON A PORTION OF SECOND STREET )

RESOLUTION NO. 23  
for 1989

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be restricted on a portion of Second Street between Ash Street and Sherman Street; and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking shall be restricted to 15 minute parking on a portion of Second Street between Sherman Street and Ash Street, more specifically described as that curb side parking area on the west side of Second Street beginning 116 feet south of the Ash Street right of way centerline and extending southward 22 feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings may be painted in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

This Resolution supercedes and replaces all other Resolutions or parts thereof governing parking at this location.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 9th day of August, 1989.
