RESOLUTION NO. 4

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that stop signs be installed on Olive Street at its intersection with Second Street; and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:


Stop signs will be installed on Olive Street to regulate eastbound and westbound traffic on Olive Street at 2nd Street.

Suitable signs shall be erected in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
