

WHEREAS, the Oregon State Legislature has enacted House Bill 2282, which establishes the procedure for seizure and forfeiture of certain property relating to illegal drug activity; and

WHEREAS, Section 2(6) of House Bill 2282 defines "forfeiture counsel" as meaning an attorney designated to represent a forfeiting agency in forfeiture actions or proceedings; and

WHEREAS, Section 4 through Section 11 of House Bill 2282 defines duties of forfeiture counsel in representing the City in civil asset forfeiture cases; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby determines that it is in the best interest of the City to designate forfeiture counsel pursuant to such legislation,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council as follows:


1. Pursuant to House Bill 2282, 1989 Oregon Session Laws, Chapter 791, that the Lebanon City Attorney is hereby designated as "forfeiture counsel" and shall hereafter represent the City of Lebanon in matters pertaining to the application of such session laws.

2. A copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to the Linn County Board of Commissioners and to the Asset Forfeiture Oversight Advisory Committee of the State of Oregon.
