A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING STREET) RESOLUTION NO. 25 PARKING ON A PORTION OF MORTON ST.) for 1990

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be prohibited on a portion of Morton Street between Highway 20 and North Main Street; and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that a parking zone be removed on a portion of Morton Street between Highway 20 and North Main Street; and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking shall be prohibited on the south side of Morton Street beginning 62 feet west of the centerline of Highway 20 and extending westward 46 feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

This Resolution supercedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.
