

A RESOLUTION REMOVING A LOADING )  
ZONE IN THE CITY OF LEBANON )

RESOLUTION NO. 25  
for 1991

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that a loading zone be removed along Ash Street between 2nd Street and 3rd Street.

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

The existing loading zone as described in Resolution Number 39-1977 shall be removed and designated as available parking space.


Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designations shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at these locations.
