A RESOLUTION CREATING LOADING AND HANDICAPPED PARKING ZONES)	RESOLUTION NO. 20 for 1991

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that loading and a handicapped parking zones be created along 2nd Street between Vine Street and Ash Street.

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

The loading zone shall be begin at a point 106 feet from the northern curb line of Ash Street and extend northward for a distance of 23 feet. The handicapped parking zone shall begin at a point 83 feet from the northern curb line of Ash Street and extend northward a distance of 23 feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designations shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at these locations.

Passed by the Council by a vote of $\frac{5}{100}$ for and $\frac{0}{100}$ against and approved by the Mayor this $\frac{26 \pm h}{100}$ day of $\frac{5}{100}$, 1991.
