

A RESOLUTION REMOVING A )  
LOADING ZONE AND A PORTION )  
OF A NO PARKING ZONE )

RESOLUTION NO. 30  
for 1991

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that a loading zone be removed along Sherman Street between Park Street and Grove Street and to remove a portion of no parking along Park Street between Sherman Street and Grant Street.

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

The existing loading zone as described in Resolution Number 48-1976 shall be removed and designated as available parking space. Also, a portion of no parking along Park Street shall be removed starting at a point 20 feet south of Sherman Street and extending south a distance of 37 feet.


Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designations shall be part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon.

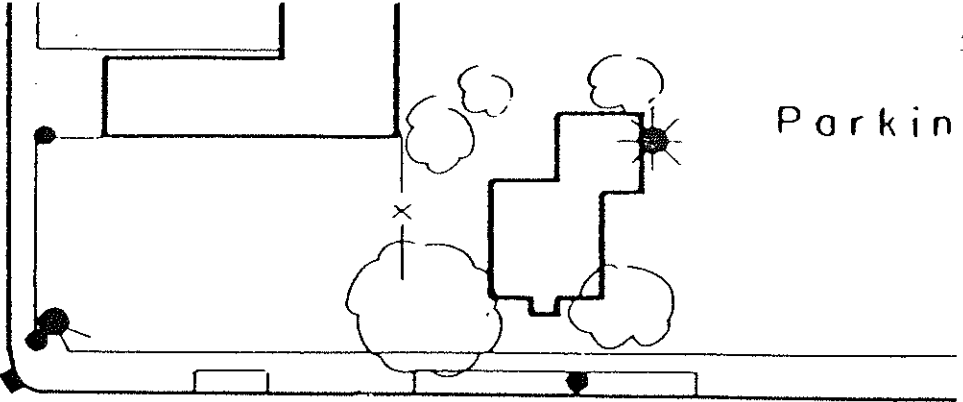
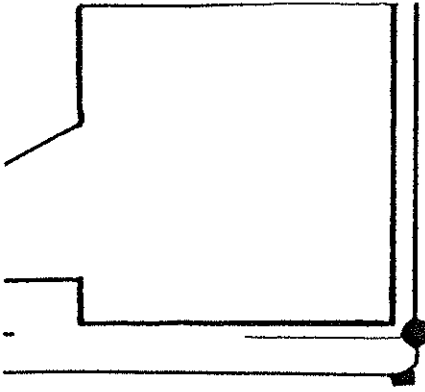
This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at these locations.

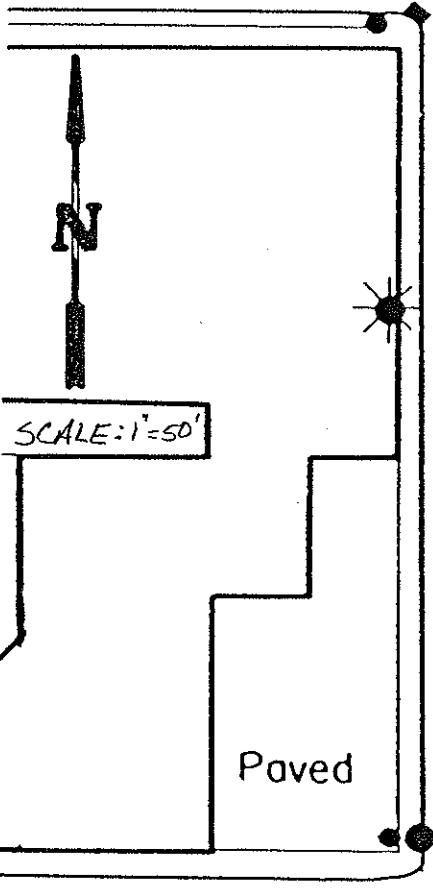

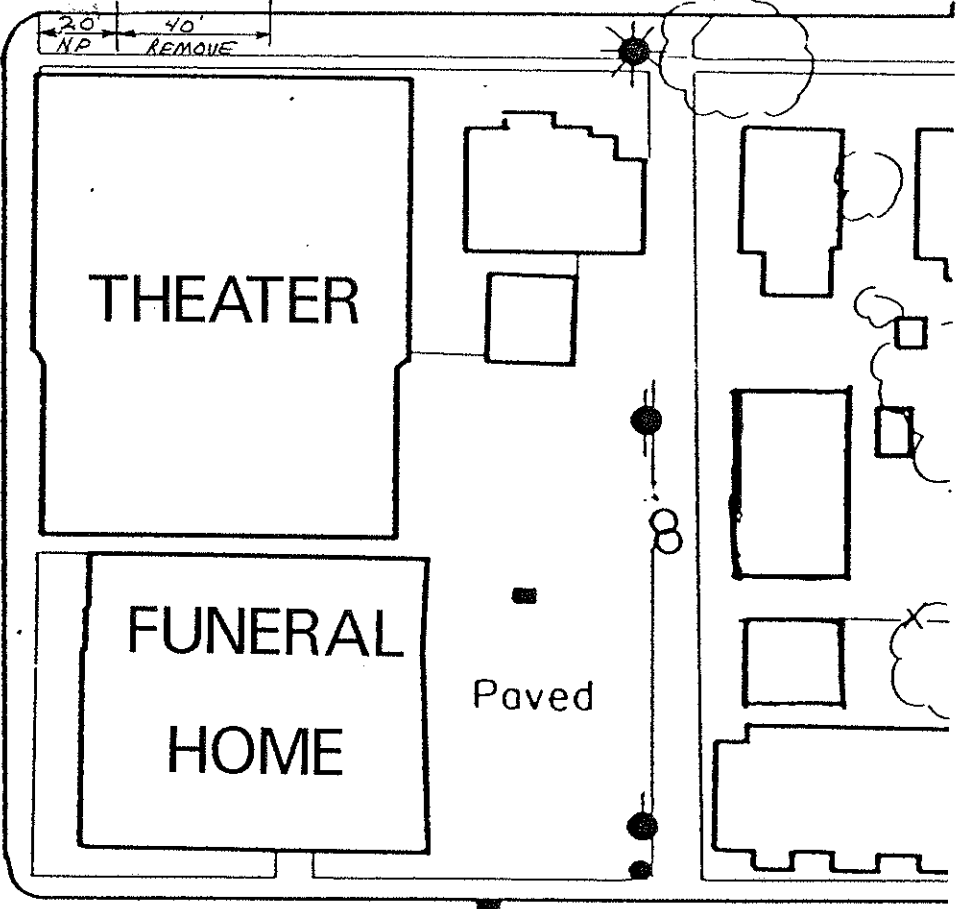


**SHERMAN STREET**
