

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING STREET)
PARKING ON A PORTION OF OLIVE ST.)

RESOLUTION NO. 57
for 1991

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be prohibited on a portion of Olive Street between 2nd Street and 3rd Street; and, WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking shall be prohibited on the south side of Olive Street beginning at the western right of way line of 2nd Street and extend to the eastern right of way line of 3rd Street.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.


This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.
