

A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING STREET )  
PARKING ON A PORTION OF HARRISON ST. )

RESOLUTION NO. 29  
for 1992

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be restricted on a portion of Harrison Street between 2nd and 4th Streets; and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) Parking shall be restricted, except for the purpose of loading and unloading handicapped passengers only, between the hours of 9:00 am and 2:00 pm Monday through Friday in the following described area:

On the south side of Harrison Street beginning at a point 240 feet west from the southwest corner of 2nd and Harrison Streets and extending westward 30 feet.

- 2) Parking shall be restricted to 15-minute parking only between the hours of 9:00 am and 2:00 pm Monday through Friday in the following described area:

On the south side of Harrison Street beginning at a point 270 feet west from the southwest corner of 2nd and Harrison Streets and extending westward 43 feet.


Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 9<sup>th</sup> day of Sept., 1992.
