FUNDS FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS)

RESOLUTION NO. 32
FOR 1992

WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 1992-93 the City of Lebanon expects to receive unanticipated funds in the amount of \$350,060 for the specific purpose of providing funds for the City of Lebanon to make Street Improvements.

WHEREAS, Oregon Local Budget Law, under ORS 294.326(2), provides that money from any unanticipated grant which has been transferred to a municipal corporation for a specific purpose may be lawfully expended after enactment of an appropriation resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Lebanon hereby adopts this resolution in the full amount of \$350,060 for the purposes shown below, and is hereby appropriated as follows:


