INC., PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 1999, ) For 1992
FOR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT IN THE )
CITY OF LEBANON.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lebanon has received a proposal for rates to be charged by Albany-Lebanon Sanitation, Inc., for the purpose of solid waste management in the City of Lebanon, and to be effective as of January 1, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the following factors in determining the appropriate rate to be charged by Albany-Lebanon Sanitation, Inc.:

- 1. The cost of performing the service provided by Albany-Lebanon Sanitation, Inc.
- 2. The anticipated increase in the cost of providing the service.
- 3. The need for equipment replacement and the need for additional equipment to meet service needs; compliance with federal, state and local law, ordinances and regulations; or technical change.
- 4. The investment of Albany-Lebanon Sanitation, Inc., and the value of its business and the necessity that Albany-Lebanon Sanitation, Inc., have a reasonable rate of return.
  - 5. The rates in other cities for similar service.
  - 6. The public interest; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has called for public comment upon proposed rates to be charged by Albany-Lebanon Sanitation,

Inc., which public comment was considered at a duly and regularly scheduled session of the City Council on November 11, 1992, with due notice being provided to the citizens of Lebanon; and the City Council having reviewed, examined and heard the presentation of representatives of Albany-Lebanon Sanitation, Inc.; now, therefore

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BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Lebanon as follows:

- 1. The City Council makes the following findings:
- **a.** The cost of performing the service provided by Albany-Lebanon Sanitation, Inc., is reasonably reflected in the proposed rate structure.
- anticipates increases in the cost of providing solid waste management, including increases in fees charged to Albany-Lebanon Sanitation, Inc., for depositing solid waste at the Coffin Butte Landfill and other anticipated increased costs.
- the need for equipment replacement and the need for additional equipment to meet service needs; further compliance with federal, state and local law, ordinances and regulations; and technological changes.
- d. The proposed rates provide a reasonable rate of return for Albany-Lebanon Sanitation, Inc., considering the investment of Albany-Lebanon Sanitation, Inc., in the value of its business.
- e. The proposed rates are fair and adequate considering the rates charged in other cities for similar service.

- $\boldsymbol{f}_{\star}$  . It is in the best interests of the public to adopt such proposed rates.
- 2. The City Council approves, effective January 1, 1993, the Rates which are reflected in Exhibit "A" which is attached herewith and incorporated by reference. The approved Rates under this Resolution are further identified in Exhibit "A" as the "Proposed Rates" and are hereby approved pursuant to the provisions of Section 13 of Ordinance No. 1999.
