

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING STREET) RESOLUTION NO. 24
PARKING ON A PORTION OF TANGENT) for 1993
STREET, 2ND STREET, MORTON STREET)
AND SANTIAM HIGHWAY)

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be prohibited on a portion of the following streets:

1. Tangent Street between 2nd Street and the east side of the railroad tracks;
2. 2nd Street between Tangent and Morton Streets;
3. Morton Street between Santiam Highway and 2nd Street; and
4. Santiam Highway from Dodge Street north to the south side of the railroad tracks.;
and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:


Parking shall be prohibited on both sides of the following streets: Tangent Street between 2nd Street and the east side of the railroad tracks; 2nd Street between Tangent and Morton Streets; Morton Street between Santiam Highway and 2nd Street; and Santiam Highway from Dodge Street north to the south side of the railroad tracks.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at these locations.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 23 day of June, 1993.
