

A RESOLUTION REINSTATING STREET) RESOLUTION NO. 30
PARKING ON A PORTION OF MAIN) for 1993
STREET)

WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommended that parking be prohibited on Main Street from Dodge Street north to the south side of the railroad tracks; and

WHEREAS, the Lebanon City Council, by Resolution No. 24 for 1993, approved the parking prohibition; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that circumstances exist which justify the restoration of street parking on a portion of Main Street, those circumstances including the need of adjacent residences and the ability to alternatively meet traffic needs while including street parking on a portion of Main Street; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Street parking shall be reinstated on the east side of Main Street from Wheeler Street north to the railroad crossing in the same locations and manner as existed prior to Resolution Number 24 for 1993; and

Section 2. Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon; and


Section 3. This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location, specifically Resolution Number 24 for 1993.
