

A RESOLUTION REGARDING TRAFFIC)

RESOLUTION NO. 33
for 1993

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that stop signs be installed on Garvord Street at its intersection with Park Drive; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon; now therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs will be installed on Garvord Street to regulate eastbound and westbound traffic on Garvord Street at Park Drive; and

Section 2. The existing stop sign on Park Drive at its intersection with Garvord Street will be removed; and


Section 3. Suitable signs shall be erected in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
