WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Lebanon has entered into intergovernmental agreements with Linn County for the reconstruction of Grant Street (County Road Number 24) and for distribution of County Federal Forest Receipts; and

WHEREAS, both agreements require the City of Lebanon to accept transfer of jurisdiction of county roads under the provisions of ORS 373.270; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Lebanon deems it necessary, expedient and for the best interests of the City of Lebanon to acquire jurisdiction over a portion of Grant Street (County Road Number 24) from Main Street to the South Santiam River bridge and approximately 110 feet of River Road (County Road Number 719) adjacent to Tax Lot 4101, Assessor's Map 12-2W-14AC, to the same extent as the city has over other public streets and alleys of the City; and the City of Lebanon hereby requests surrender of the same of the Board of County Commissioners of Linn County;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Lebanon as follows:

Section 1. The governing body of the City of Lebanon hereby determines that it is necessary, expedient, and for the best interests of the city to accept jurisdiction over a portion of Grant Street (County Road Number 24) from Main Street to the South Santiam River bridge and approximately 110 feet of River Road (County Road Number 719) adjacent to Tax Lot 4101, Assessor's Map 12-2W-14AC.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Lebanon hereby requests of the Board of Commissioners for Linn County the surrender of jurisdiction of said portion of a portion of Grant Street (County Road Number 24), from Main Street to the South Santiam River bridge and approximately 110 feet of River Road (County Road Number 719) adjacent to Tax Lot 4101, Assessor's Map 12-2W-14AC.

<u>Section 3.</u> A copy of this resolution shall be forwarded by the City Administrator of the City of Lebanon to the Board of County Commissioners for Linn County upon the passage hereof.
