WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be prohibited on a portion of Milton

Street 120' east and 20' west from the intersection of Milton and Franklin; and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of

traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON

AS FOLLOWS:

Parking shall be prohibited on the north side of Milton Street beginning from the intersection of Milton and Franklin and extending east 120' and west for a distance of 20'.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.
