
WHEREAS, Section 906 of the 1990 National Affordable Housing Act prohibits the use of excessive force against non-violent civil-rights demonstrators and;

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon has certified in its 1993 Grant Contract that it will comply with state and federal laws and regulations in Exhibit C of the Grant Contract;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that it is the policy of the City of Lebanon that;

- (1) its law enforcement personnel shall not use excessive force against any individuals engaged in non-violent civil-rights demonstrations, and
- (2) applicable state and local laws that prohibit physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location which is the subject of such non-violent civil-rights demonstrations within its jurisdiction shall be enforced.

Passed by the Lebanon City Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against on this 16th day of May, 1994.
