Resolution No. 41
for 1994

WHEREAS, the Lebanon City Council did create, by Ordinance No. 1981, the Downtown Sidewalk Improvement Local Improvement District (LID) in September of 1985; and

WHEREAS, the sidewalks were installed in that same year; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation did not inform the City of Lebanon of the final costs of the sidewalk construction in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to encourage downtown development; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon has a sidewalk incentive program to encourage the repair of sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the costs of this LID have already been paid using Federal Revenue Sharing funds which are no longer available; and


WHEREAS; the LID was formed over nine years ago; and

WHEREAS; pursuant to chapter 12.20.360 of the Lebanon Municipal Code the City Council has the authority to abandon, conclude, or rescind an LID;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

1. The LID is hereby concluded without final costs being assessed against the benefitted properties.
