

A RESOLUTION REGARDING TRAFFIC)
IN THE CITY OF LEBANON PROHIBITING)
LEFT HAND TURNS FROM SECOND)
STREET ONTO ACADEMY STREET)

RESOLUTION NO. 7
for 1994

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended prohibiting left hand turns from Second Street onto Academy Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of pedestrians and vehicular traffic in the City of Lebanon; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Left hand turns from Second Street onto Academy Street will be prohibited; and

Section 2. Suitable signs shall be erected in the appropriate places; and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon; and

Section 3. The existing stop sign on Second Street at its intersection with Academy Street will be removed; and


Section 4. This resolution shall be effective as of June 13, 1994.
