RESOLUTION NO. 88
for 1995

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be restricted on a portion of Harrison Street at the intersection of 3rd. Street and Harrison Street; and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for providing handicapped parking to Santiam School,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking shall be restricted to one handicap parking space on a portion of Harrison Street at the intersection of 3rd. Street and Harrison Street; specifically, the south side of Harrison Street beginning 6 feet east from the wheelchair ramp and extending 20 feet east.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the parking regulations of the City of Lebanon.


This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.
